Cost of Services

We will gladly file insurance claims when appropriate. If you have insurance that provides coverage for services, you will be responsible for your co-pay and any deductible that is not met. If insurance is not an option, or not desirable, we will provide a sliding scale for services. This scale varies based on the professional seen and the household income of the client. All financial charges are payable at the time services are rendered. Please speak with our office manager for further details regarding your financial responsibilities. If you have insurance, please have your card available when you call.

Length of Treatment

There is no exact answer to the length of treatment. It is primarily dependent on the issues being addressed and the motivation of the client. You are encouraged to speak with your counselor regarding your individual goals for treatment. Staff at CWCC also assign homework assignments that are uniquely designed to continue the healing process and assist clients in making progress outside the counseling session.
